Class Description: We will be creating the Giant Dahlia appliqué using Marti Michell's **Giant Dahlia Template Set**. The set includes templates and patterns to make a Queen/Double Quilt including borders. Intermediate to Advanced level

Items to Bring: Required items for class success!

Sewing machine – in good working order, threaded with coordinating color, spare needle, scant ¼ inch foot.

Bobbins – pre-wound with matching threads or neutrals such as light grey or off white

Supplies:

- Cutting mat
- Olfa cutter
- extra blade
- scissors
- seam ripper
- 6x24 and 6x6 inch rulers with a 45 degree angle
- flat flower head pins
- regular quilt pins
- pin cushion
- quilting marking pen or pencil
- colored pencils
- paper and pencil

Required: **Giant Dahlia Template Set** #8949, by Marti Michell; Available at Eddie's Quilting Bee item #13109

Fabric Requirements: see chart on page 1 of Giant Dahlia Quilt Instruction book included with the Template Set. You will not need to decide background or binding, or batting until later. Include varieties of light medium and dark and only a small print in some fabric choices. Batiks and muted dyes work well for this project to give it dimension and luminosity.
